The work consists, in general of furnishing all the material, labor, tools, and equipment, and perform all the work required to accomplish the work as follows:

Traffic signals at the intersection of Solano Street and Marguerite Avenue including pole foundations, standards, conduit, wiring, controller, electrical work, detectors, testing, start-up and all related work, thermoplastic centerline striping and pavement markings, roadway excavation, removal and replacement of reinforced concrete valley gutters, removal and replacement of concrete sidewalks, curb and gutter, and curb returns with handicap access ramps and truncated domes, aggregate base rock, asphalt concrete paving, modular block retaining wall, and all related work, as shown on the Plans and described in the Contract Documents.

No proposal will be accepted unless it is made on a Proposal form furnished by the City of Corning. Each Proposal must be accompanied by cash, certified or cashier's check, or bidder's bond payable to the City of Corning for an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the amount bid, such guaranty to be forfeited should the bidder to whom the Contract is awarded fail to execute the contract Documents.

Pursuant to Section 1770, and following, of the California Labor Code, the successful bidder shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. Copies of such prevailing rate of per diem wages are on file at City Hall. The successful bidder shall post a copy of such determination at the job site.

No proposal will be accepted from a Contractor who is not currently licensed in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 9, Division III of the Business and Professions Code. Subcontractors shall also be licensed as required by said code. Bidders must possess a current Class "A" General Engineering Contractor License.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS (Cont'd.)

The Director of Public Works, and the City Engineer, will conduct a **non-mandatory** pre-bid field review on **August 5, (Thursday), 2010, at 1:30 P.M.**, commencing at City Hall, 794 Third Street, Corning, California. Potential bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid field review.

Contract Documents, including Plans and Specifications, may be obtained at the office of the City Clerk, Corning City Hall, 794 Third Street, Corning, CA 96021, (530-824-7029), free of charge for the first set, and \$25.00 for each additional set.

Contract documents, including Plans and Specifications, are available for inspection at the Shasta Builder's Exchange, 2990 Innsbruck Drive, Redding, California; Valley Contractor's Exchange, 832 Richland Road, Yuba City, California; and Valley Contractor's Exchange, 951 E. 8th Street, Chico, California.

The Contract, if awarded, will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder as determined by the City. The City of Corning reserves the right to waive irregularities, accept or reject any and all bids, and make that award which is in the best interest of the City.

Bidders are hereby notified that in accordance with the provisions of Government Code Section 4590, securities may be substituted for any monies which the City may withhold pursuant to the terms of the Contract to insure performance.
