### CITY MANAGER:

#### **Proposition 68 Park Development and Community Revitalization Grant:**

The grant evaluator for the Proposition 68 Park Development and Community Revitalization Grant is on medical leave until March 2<sup>nd</sup>. I am not certain whether this will delay the announcement of grant awards. I am awaiting a return email for further information. To best position the City, on behalf of the City I have made offers (contingent on receipt of the grant) on all three properties. I am awaiting response from the property owners utilizing the services of Better Choice Realty.

#### **Patrol:**

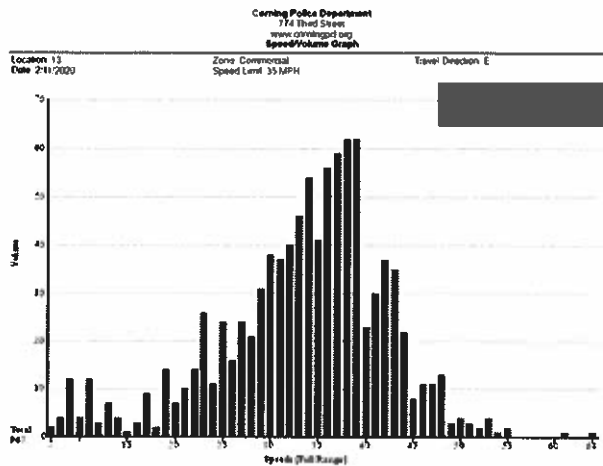
In addition to responding to 117 calls for service, a total of 27 officer reports were taken and there were 117 officer-initiated incidents, including 76 traffic stops. Officers made 15 misdemeanor and 6 felony arrests. Officers issued 18 citations, of which; 14 were misdemeanors, 1 were parking, 1 was unclassified, and 2 were infractions during the period of February 6, 2020 through February 12, 2020.

Officers continue to participate in POST Portal Training and Lexipol Daily Training Bulletins. Other POST on-line training continues for Patrol and Dispatch personnel.
