CITY MANAGER:

Annual Financial Statements:

The annual Financial Statements will be presented at the February 25th City Council meeting.

Mid-Year Budget Review:

The Mid-Year Budget Review will also be presented at the February 25th City Council meeting.

Meetings:

I am attending a City Manager's Department Conference meeting on Wednesday through Friday of this week. I will be taking February 10th and 11th off but will be present at the City Council meeting on the evening of February 11th.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

Palm Tree Trimming Contract:

The palm tree trimming is planned to start on February 10th to begin the project and should be complete within the week. Door hangers should have been placed on the doors of residents in the areas of the palm tree trimming this week. No Parking signs will be placed in affected areas the day before the trimming is to occur in that area.

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

Patrol:

In addition to responding to 156 calls for service, a total of 31 officer reports were taken and there were 161 officer-initiated incidents, including 88 traffic stops. Officers made 16 misdemeanor and 4 felony arrests. Officers issued 35 citations, of which; 15 were misdemeanors, 1 was a felony, 5 were parking, 1 was animal, and 13 were infractions during the period of January 29, 2020 through February 5, 2020.

Training:

Officers continue to participate in POST Portal Training and Lexipol Daily Training Bulletins. Other POST on-line training continues for Patrol and Dispatch personnel. This week we had a department wide CPR and First Aid training. One officer attended DUI Detection-Field Sobriety.

FIRE DEPARTMENT:

Corning Volunteer Fire Department Call Volume:

The Corning Volunteer Fire Department responded to 18 calls for service last week; they consisted of: 15 medicals, 1 mutual aid fire, 1 traffic collision and 1 investigation.

Orland Volunteer Fire Department Call Volume:

The Orland Volunteer Fire Department was dispatched to 5 calls for service last week; they consisted of: 2 medicals, 1 fire, 1 traffic collision and 1 investigation.

Capay Volunteer Fire Department Call Volume:

The Capay Volunteer Fire Department was dispatched to 1 medical aid.

Corning Volunteer Fire Department Training (CVFD):

Training for the CVFD consisted of putting together and familiarizing themselves with their new SCBA's. They will be put in service following a "fit" test, orientation and training by the Vendor.
