CITY MANAGER:

Coronavirus (COVID-19):

A local emergency was declared by the City Mayor on March 19th to be ratified by the City Council on March 24th. The Governor of CA ordered a directive to stay at home on March 19th. Most employees are essential employees and their daily work has not changed. The City has been preparing for this possibility. All things considered we are prepared. Employees that have the ability to work from home are working from home. They have access to emails, hard copy files they readily use, and the City server. There are notices on the front doors of how to contact City Staff for the type of business being performed or service needed. Instructions on how to contact the City will be available on the City home page as well.

The City Council Meeting will be held via conference Call at (351) 999-4082. There is no pin or access code required.

Waste Management:

Waste Management's call center is currently down as they transition their employees to work remotely. RESIDENTIAL SERVICE RELATED questions (e.g. my can was not picked up, my cart is broken, what is recyclable, bulky item pick up scheduling, etc.) can always be handled by calling your local Corning Waste Management representatives at 530-824-4690. Please note, this has no impact to your collection service; there are currently no COVID-19-related service interruptions. Billing related questions can be answered by calling 530-824-7020.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

Animal Shelter Building:

Public Works Staff has started the demolition of the animal shelter block building.

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

Patrol:

In addition to responding to 125 calls for service, a total of 21 officer reports were taken and there were 77 officer-initiated incidents, including 45 traffic stops. Officers made 13 misdemeanor and 1 felony arrests. Officers issued 22 citations, of which; 12 were misdemeanors, 5 were parking, and 5 were infractions during the period of March 12, 2020 through March 18, 2020.

Training:

Officers continue to participate in POST Portal Training and Lexipol Daily Training Bulletins. Other POST on-line training continues for Patrol and Dispatch personnel.
