## THE CORNING FRIDAY NOTES

### **CITY MANAGER:**

#### **West Street Closure Ad-Hoc Committee:**

The West Street Closure Ad-Hoc Committee met on March 3<sup>rd</sup> regarding the possible permanent closure of West Street between Marin and South Streets. I believe a compromise may have been reached for full City Council consideration. The City is awaiting further information from the School District.

#### **Dangerous Building M&M Auto Parts:**

The City needs to obtain a warrant in order for a Structural Engineer to inspect the building. A Structural Engineer needs to inspect the connections in order to design a fix/repair.

#### **Franchise Hauling Agreement Negotiations with Waste Management:**

I will be meeting again with Waste Management regarding Franchise Hauling Agreement negotiations on March 9<sup>th</sup>. Waste Management has indicated to me they have dropped their request for a rate increase.

#### **Senate Bill 1383 Joint Powers Agreement Amendment:**

The Joint Powers Agreement between the Cities of Red Bluff, Corning, Tehama and the County of Tehama is being proposed to be amended in light of Senate Bill 1383, which requires organics collection and recycling. The Tehama County Solid Waste Management Agency Full Board will consider the amendment on March 9<sup>th</sup>. After which time each City and the County will consider the proposed amendment. We can expect increases in the tipping fee and collection rates as a result of this legislation in the next five years.

### **POLICE DEPARTMENT:**

#### **Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 130 calls for service, a total of 21 officer reports were taken and there were 91 officer-initiated incidents, including 54 traffic stops. Officers made 10 misdemeanor and 2 felony arrests. Officers issued 20 citations, of which; 10 were misdemeanors, 7 were parking, and 3 were infractions during the period of February 27, 2020 through March 4, 2020.

#### **Training:**

Officers continue to participate in POST Portal training and Lexipol Daily Training Bulletins. Other POST on-line training continues for Patrol and Dispatch personnel.

#### **Community Participation:**

February 28<sup>th</sup> Chief Fears attended a ribbon cutting for the new cellular phone tower in Rancho Tehama.

Also, on February 28<sup>th</sup> Sergeant Anderson, Officer Portillo and Officer McIntyre attended Important Figures in the Corning Community Day at West Street School. They enjoyed lunch and visits with the children.

### **FIRE DEPARTMENT:**

#### **Corning Volunteer Fire Department Call Volume:**

The Corning Volunteer Fire Department responded to 27 calls for service last week, they were; 22 medicals, 1 traffic collision, 3 fires and 1 public service.

#### **The Orland, Capay, Butte City, Bayliss, Glenn Codora and Artois Volunteer Fire Departments Call Volume:**

The Orland, Capay, Butte City, Bayliss, Glenn Codora and Artois Volunteer Fire Departments were dispatched to a combined total of 10 calls for service last week. These consisted off: 6 medical, 2 fires, 1 major mutual aid fire (Grizzley Incident) and 1 traffic collision.
