## **POLICE DEPARTMENT:**

### **Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 214 calls for service, a total of 39 officer reports were taken and there were 129 officer-initiated incidents, including 68 traffic stops. Officers made 17 misdemeanor and 2 felony arrests. Officers issued 25 citations, of which; 17 were misdemeanors, 4 were parking, 3 were animal and 1 were infractions during the period of September 4 through September 11, 2019.

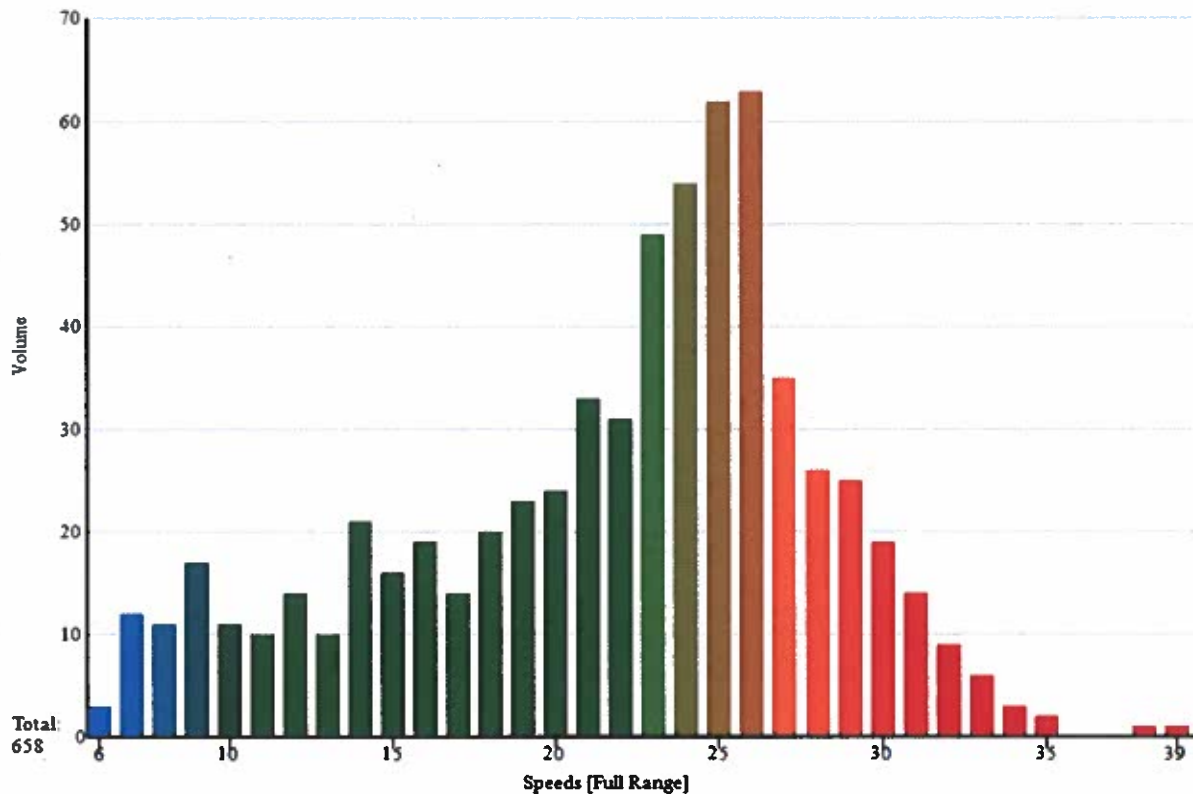
### **Training:**
