### **CITY MANAGER:**

#### **Ten -Year Homeless Plan:**

The City Council will consider approval of the County Ten Year Homeless Plan on September 25<sup>th</sup>. The Tehama County Board of Supervisors will also consider approval of the Plan on the morning of the 25<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Meeting regarding Airport Grant Funding:**

I am meeting with Louis Davies and Barbara Boot on September 24<sup>th</sup> to discuss grant opportunities available to the Corning Municipal Airport.

#### **Recreation Program:**

The City Council will consider approval of the purchase of recreation program software at its meeting on the 25<sup>th</sup>. The software will allow participants to sign up for courses online thereby saving a significant amount of staff time and creating better flexibility to the public. The cost of the software will be grant-funded.

#### **Food Truck Tuesday:**

The Food Truck Tuesday held on September 18<sup>th</sup> was heavily attended. I heard many compliments from attendees about how grateful they were for community events like these. I'd like to thank all City Employees and Volunteers that were involved in making this event a success. It most certainly takes a team effort! Thank you!

#### **City Managers' Meetings:**

I met with the County Schools Superintendent and the County Chief Administrator on September 20<sup>th</sup>. I received an update regarding the removal of debris from the Specialized Fibers/Omega Waste property. Debris removal will not occur this winter. Plans are being made to protect the site throughout the rainy season.

The Sacramento Regional City Managers Meeting will be held on September 28<sup>th</sup>.

### **PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:**

#### **Senior Center:**

Contractor Cleanrite-Buildrite has informed the Public Works Director and Building Official that the metal roofing material will not be available to them until October 26<sup>th</sup>. Once the building repairs have been made, the roof will be 'water tight' until the metal roofing can be installed in late October. The project will not be issued a project final until the roofing work is completely finished.

**Tree Trimming Contract:**

The tree trimming project was awarded to West Coast Arborists, Inc. (WCA) at the September 11<sup>th</sup> City Council Meeting. The pre-construction meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, September 25, 2018 at 8:00 a.m. at City Hall.

**Meetings:**

Tehama County Regional Transportation Planning Agency; Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) Meeting will be meeting at 3:00 p.m. on October 3, 2018 at the Tuscan Room, 727 Oak Street, Red Bluff.

**POLICE DEPARTMENT:**

**Patrol:**

In addition to responding to 181 calls for service, a total of 19 officer reports were taken and there were 115 officer-initiated incidents, including 77 traffic stops. Officers made 7 misdemeanor and 1 felony arrests. Officers issued 17 citations, of which; 7 were misdemeanors, 9 were infractions, and 1 was unclassified during the period of September 12, 2018 through September 19, 2018.

**Training:**

Officers continue to participate in POST Portal Training and Lexipol Daily Training Bulletins. Other Officer Field Training and Dispatcher Training is continuing.

**FIRE DEPARTMENT:**

**Call Volume:**

The Corning Volunteer Fire Department responded to 12 calls for service last week. These consisted of: 7 medical aids, 4 fires, and 1 traffic collision.

Orland and/or Capay Fire Departments were dispatched to 15 calls for service. These consisted of 11 medicals, 2 fires, and 2 public service calls.

**Training:**

Training for the Corning Volunteer Fire Department consisted of a practice/training burn near North and East Streets.
