We appreciate your cooperation in regard to City Municipal Code Chapter 10.32 – Abandoned or Inoperative Vehicles, which states in part, "the presence of an abandoned, wrecked, dismantled or inoperative vehicle or parts thereof, on private or public property not including highways, except as expressly permitted in this chapter, is declared to constitute a public nuisance which may be abated as such in accordance with the provisions of this chapter. (Ord. 265 §1(part), 1971).

As the registered and/or legal owner of record of the above-listed vehicle(s), or parts thereof, you are hereby requested to abate said vehicle(s) within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice.

As the registered and/or legal owner of record of the above-listed vehicle(s), or parts thereof, you are hereby notified that you may, within ten (10) days, request a Public Hearing. If such a request is not received by the City Clerk of the City of Corning within such 10-day period, the Chief of Police, or his/her designee, shall have the authority to abate and remove said vehicle, or parts thereof, without a Hearing.
